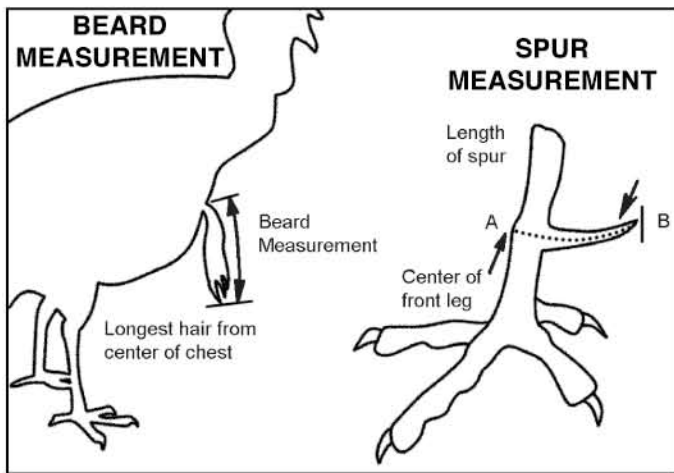

 1) Add the appropriate entry fees together as necessary.
 2) All entries must be complete, signed by hunter and accompanied by fees and photographs of the trophy.
 3) Please clearly label back of photo with name of hunter, name and score of animal, and date taken.
 For simple horns and unbranched antlers:
 1 Photo included
 For animals with branched antlers:
 1 from FRONT; 1 from LEFT; 1 from RIGHT

It is important that our members realize that if your animal qualifies for the ACF Big Game Crossbow Register, it also qualifies for the Safari Club International Record Book or Trophy Animals. We encourage our members to support SCI and register your animals in their book as well.

Measuring A Wild Turkey All measurements on the turkey are done in 1/16 increments. The ACF measuring system does not include the weight of the turkey when calculating the final score, weight can not be re-measured and therefore is listed as supplemental information.

Measuring the Spurs: Both the right and left spurs are measured. The Measurement should begin at the center point of the front of the leg at a 90 degree angle to the base of the spur. Hold the cable tightly at this point and continue measuring by following the curvature of the spur to the tip. The measurement will be multiplied by two to establish the total score of each spur.

Measuring the Beard: A beard must be measured from the base (thickest area attached to the chest) to the tip or longest feather in the beard. Use a multiplier of 2 (ex: 8-8/16 x 2 = a total score of 17) to receive the total score for the beard.

Add together the total points of the spurs, and length of the beard.
